



## **NICCSJ Novena to Immaculate Conception 2022**

### **(End of Year Novena)**

This novena may be made anytime, but it is especially good to honor the Mother of God in her Divine privilege by making the Novena between November 29-December 7, the eve of the Solemnity of Immaculate Conception on December 8<sup>th</sup>.

“Immaculate Conception” is the title given to Mother Mary that celebrates her conception free from original sin. The Church believes and teaches that Mary was not only conceived without sin but was also free of sin throughout her life. In Luke 1:28, theologians believed that the angel Gabriel’s greeting, which translates “*Hail, full of grace*”, meant that Mary was fully favored and filled with an abundance of grace. God’s grace kept her free from sin throughout her life. God chose her from the beginning to be the Mother of Jesus and thus, made her worthy and without sin. Trusting confidently in the intercessions of our Blessed Mother Mary, let us pray this Novena with our intentions, devotion, and attention. Amen

  - e. For peace, security, and respect for human life in our home country Nigeria, especially in the Igbo Land
  - f. Peace & Progress for all the Igbo Catholic Communities, especially the Igbo Catholic Communities of the Bay Area
  - g. For the success of our 360 Project, 15<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Memoir, & Devotional App
  - h. For God’s special healing on all of us and for those who are sick, especially Dr. Adaure Onyewuenyi
  - a. For the deceased members of our families, especially Ezinne Gladys Obilor & Sir Christopher Onyenanu, and all the names in our virtual book of remembrance & for God’s consolation & strength on all the bereaved families

O Mary, who by your holy Immaculate Conception did enter the world free from stain, in your mercy obtain for us from Jesus the special favor which we now so earnestly seek... **Intentions**

**General Opening Prayer: DAY FOUR: Friday, December 2nd, 2022**

O Mary, Mother of God, endowed in your glorious Immaculate Conception with the fullness of grace; unique among women in that you are both mother and virgin; Mother of Christ and Virgin of Christ, we ask you to look down with a tender heart from your throne and listen to our prayers as we earnestly ask that you obtain for us the favor for which we now plead... **Intentions**
