



NICCSJ 2021 Novena to Our Lady of Mount Carmel
(Feast Day, July 16th)

Mount Carmel is the biblical site where the prophet Elijah battled with the 450 priests of Baal, which led to their defeat and ruin. It was also where Elijah sent his servant seven times to the mountaintop to look for rain after years of drought which ended as he proclaimed (1 Kings 18:19-44). The title of Our Lady of Carmel can be traced back to the hermits (Carmelites) who used to live in the renowned and blessed Mount Carmel. These pious and austere Carmelites prayed in expectation of the advent of a Virgin-Mother. Thousands of years later, our Lady, Mary appeared to St. Simon Stock, a Carmelite priest, in the exact same location on July 16th, 1251. In this appearance of Mary, she is known as Our Lady of Mount Carmel. She appeared holding Jesus as a child in one arm and on her other arm, a Scapular. She promised that all those who wear Scapular and follow Christ faithfully will be brought by Our Mother Mary into heaven at their deaths. Praying the Novena to Our Lady of Mount Carmel has been an age-long practice through which Christians have entrusted their intentions to God through the powerful intercessions of our Mother Mary. Let us continue to share in the maternal love of our Mother Mary by praying this Novena with devotion and attention. Amen

Steps:

1. **Begin-** In the name of the Father, And of the Son, And of the Holy Spirit. Amen
2. Pray the General Opening Prayer & Prayer for a particular day (like Day 1 as below)
3. Mention the intentions:
 - a. Thanksgiving to God for all our answered prayers
 - b. For Marital Blessings and Job Opportunities for all our young adults & professionals.
 - c. For peace, security, and respect for human life in our home country Nigeria, especially in the Igbo Land
 - d. Peace & Progress for all the Igbo Catholic Communities, especially the Igbo Catholic Communities of Bay Area
 - e. For the success of our 360 Project, 15th Anniversary Memoir, & Devotional App
 - f. For God's protection & healing on all of us and for those who are sick, especially Dr. Adaure Onyewuenyi, Msgr. John Sandersfeld, & Dr. Ikechukwu Chukwu
 - g. For deceased members of our families, especially Prince Val Nwogu, Ezinne Patricia Ajawara, Seminarian Stephen Unachukwu, and all the names in our virtual book of remembrance & for God's consolation & strength on all the bereaved families.
 - h. For other private intentions
4. Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet (Monday to Friday) or Rosary of Blessed Virgin Mary (Saturday & Sunday)
5. Prayer- Daily Prayer for Priests
6. Prayer for the family
7. Prayer for San Jose Diocese Eucharistic Revival
8. Prayer to Our Lady of Guadalupe for an End to Coronavirus

General Opening Prayer for Each Day

Blessed and Immaculate Virgin, splendid beauty of Carmel, you look with love on all who wear your blessed habit; look kindly on us and spread the mantle of your loving protection over all humanity. DAY ONE: Friday July 8th, 2022

O Beautiful Flower of Carmel, most fruitful vine, splendor of heaven, holy and singular, who brought forth the Son of God, still ever remaining a pure virgin, assist us in our necessity! O Star of the Sea, help and protect us! Show us that you are our Mother. *Intentions*

DAY TWO: Saturday July 9th, 2022

Most Holy Mary, Our Mother, in your great love for us you gave us the Holy Scapular of Mount Carmel, having heard the prayers of your chosen son Saint Simon Stock. Help us now to wear it faithfully and with devotion. May it be a sign to us of our desire to grow in holiness. *Intentions*

DAY THREE: Sunday July 10th, 2022

O Queen of Heaven, you gave us the Scapular as an outward sign by which we might be known as your faithful children. May we always wear it with honor by avoiding sin and imitating your virtues. Help us to be faithful to this desire of ours. *Intentions*

DAY FOUR: Monday July 11th, 2022

When you gave us, Gracious Lady, the Scapular as our Habit, you called us to be not only servants, but also your own children. We ask you to gain for us from your Son the grace to live as your children in joy, peace and love. *Intentions*

DAY FIVE: Tuesday July 12th, 2022

O Mother of Fair Love, through your goodness, as your children, we are called to live in the spirit of Carmel. Help us to live in charity with one another, prayerful as Elijah of old, and mindful of our call to minister to God's people. *Intentions*

DAY SIX: Wednesday July 13th, 2022

With loving provident care, O Mother Most Amiable, you covered us with your Scapular as a shield of defense against the Evil One. Through your assistance, may we bravely struggle against the powers of evil, always open to your Son Jesus Christ. *Intentions*

DAY SEVEN: Thursday July 14th, 2022

O Mary, Help of Christians, you assured us that wearing your Scapular worthily would keep us safe from harm. Protect us in both body and soul with your continual aid. May all that we do be pleasing to your Son and to you. *Intentions*

DAY EIGHT: Friday July 15th, 2022

You give us hope, O Mother of Mercy, that through your Scapular promise we might quickly pass through the fires of purgatory to the Kingdom of your Son. Be our comfort and our hope. Grant that our hope may not be in vain but that, ever faithful to your Son and to you, we may speedily enjoy after death the blessed company of Jesus and the saints. *Intentions*

DAY NINE: Saturday July 16th, 2022

O Most Holy Mother of Mount Carmel, when asked by a saint to grant privileges to the family of Carmel, you gave assurance of your Motherly love and help to those faithful to you and to your Son. Behold us, your children. We glory in wearing your holy habit, which makes us members of your family of Carmel, through which we shall have your powerful protection in life, at death and even after death. Look down with love, O Gate of Heaven, on all those now in their last agony! Look down graciously, O Virgin, Flower of Carmel, on all those in need of help! Look down mercifully, O Mother of our Savior, on all those who do not know that they are numbered among your children. Look down tenderly, O Queen of All Saints, on the poor souls! *Intentions:*
